All your organic shopping with member benefit

As a member of the Odin cooperative, you can participate in the member benefit system. If you do, a monthly contribution will be collected at the beginning of each month. With this

monthly contribution, you assist in paying the basic costs of the shop (energy, rent, personnel costs, etc.), ensuring that these costs do not have to be included in the final price of the products. As a result, the prices that members pay are on average 15% lower.

Your monthly contribution is entered as a balance on your member card and online account. Every time you do your shopping, the difference between the "normal price" and the member price is automatically settled with your balance. Once your balance reaches zero, the



real member benefit begins. At the end of the month, any remaining balance is automatically converted into shopping credit on your member card and online account. You can then use this to pay for your groceries. So, if you do little or no shopping during a month, your monthly contribution will not be lost. We think this is fair. The more shopping you do, the greater your benefit. But at least as important: you contribute to a fair and sustainable food chain.

The goal of the Odin apiary is to have more bees on farms and have a more natural landscape, so all insects are better off.

More and more places in The Netherlands are home to Odin bee colonies. In particular at biodynamic farms. The bees can thrive there because no pesticides are used and there is often room for flowers and other host plants.

But our colonies can also be found at other places, such as De Ceuvel centre in Amsterdam

or the Kunsthal in Rotterdam. Honey bees

help pollinate the plants on all of these locations. The Odin beekeeper places the hives and the colonies at these locations, helps with maintenance and makes suggestions for improving the food supply for the bees.

Everyone can become a co-owner of our cooperative. Currently, more than 15,000 members own Odin, and that number is growing rapidly. We can make the difference together. How does it work?

Since 2016, Odin farm De Beersche Hoeve in the town of Oostelbeers has been growing vegetables biodynamically, propagating vegetable seeds and developing new vegetable varieties on 20 hectares. The vegetable varieties grown and developed by De Beersche Hoeve are not only free in use, but also open pollinated. Crops that are open pollinated make farmers less dependent on seed suppliers for the free development of new varieties and for more variety in the field and on the plate. This is how we invest in more biodiversity with our farm.
